



ADDITIONAL CAMPERTUNITIES

These additional activities are included in the cost of summer camp for the campers who want a little more:

Counselor-In-Training (CIT)

CITs must complete an application and attend a minimum of 22 days, two of which must be the MANDATORY training days of June 16th & 17th.

An interactive experiential learning program for teens entering 7th or 8th grade who want to further develop their leadership and communication skills, as well as gain experience in planning instructional activities for young children. The program's philosophy is to provide an inside view into how a camp runs, the responsibilities of those who run it, and the skills of a camp counselor. CITs are provided opportunities to shadow counselors, allowing them to observe, study, and practice the counselors' skills. Opportunities to try newly acquired skills are provided in a supportive environment designed to encourage personal growth. CITs will receive 1st Aid/CPR training and are paid up to \$5.50/day while they learn valuable job skills such as responsibility, teamwork, and creative problem-solving.

Rocks and Robots

Summer sessions include courses where campers ages 7-17 build their own self-powered vehicle, use LEGOs and build things while incorporating everyday objects, designing, programming, building and battling Mindstorms robots or learning advanced techniques and building LEGO versions of Leonardo DaVinci's designs.

In addition, campers also get to choose between courses that include an adventure challenge. Campers can go rock climbing twice a week, learn map and compass skills and experience a high ropes challenge course.
