2. Continue to develop and implement the initial communications and outreach plan to share the Honey Creek story and foster an understanding of our unique pedagogical approach. (Specifics will include, but not be limited to, an enhanced website and social networking as well as ambassadorship within the HCCS community, to area “feeder schools” in the WISD region, and the greater educational community)
3. Collaborate with the PTO to bring HCCS fund development and support efforts under the direction of a single legal entity whose mission supports HCCS and its Strategic Goals.
