

Honey Creek Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Student Policy

OVERVIEW

Your signed Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) remains in effect even when you are using your own laptop, smartphone, iPad, iPod Touch, etc. Each time you attempt to access the network at school, you are expected to abide to the Terms and Conditions of the Student Technology AUP. Violating the Terms and Conditions of the AUP would be a Building Student Code of Conduct violation and would be dealt with by a School Building Administrator.

Students will need to update their anti-virus software before bringing their device(s) onto school property.

To use your device on the school's network, you must fill out the BYOD Student Signup form, accessible [here](#). You MUST fill this form out before asking to have your device connected.

CLASS USAGE

Each of your classroom teachers will post either a red, yellow or green dot on the wall/window next to the classroom door. The colors represent the following:

RED DOT: No student-owned devices are to be used in the classroom.

YELLOW DOT: You may use your student-owned device with permission to support teaching and learning.

GREEN DOT: You may freely use your student-owned device to support teaching and learning.

Remember, the Acceptable Use Policy and teacher discretion supercedes all of this!

PRINTING

At this time, there is no printing enabled from student-owned devices, though this may be added in the future. If you need to print, it is recommended that you email the document to yourself, save it to your Google Drive or save it on a flash drive then login on a school-owned device to retrieve and print. The Honey Creek Media Center is a great place to take care of your printing needs.

THEFT/DAMAGE

It is the responsibility of the owner to keep his/her personal technology safe and secure. Anytime there is theft or damage, you should notify your teacher and/or School Building Administration. The District, or any employees of the District, are not responsible for theft, loss or damage to your personal device(s).
