#### Storytelling with Lego

### Costs & Fees

Honey Creek Summer Day Camp allows you the flexibility to choose the DAYS of the summer that you wish to attend. The cost is **\$55.00/day** from 8am-6pm. Weekly field trips, daily swimming, and afternoon snacks are included.

Specialty camps cost **\$280** for the full-day camp (8:30am-2pm); or **\$180** for half-day camp (8:30-11:30am or 12:30-3:30pm).

Before, After, & Lunch Care is available through our day camp for those participating in Specialty Camps. Daily costs are **\$5** for Early Drop-Off, **\$5** for 11:30am-12:30pm, **\$25** for 8am-12:30pm, **\$20** for 2-6pm, and **\$35** from 11:30am-6pm.

A \$45.00 non-refundable enrollment fee is required for all campers & includes the cost of a camp t-shirt.
